Respondent and others;
- (b) Direct CERT-IN to block access to the aforesaid illegal
Online lotteries being conducted by the respondent and
Others.
- (c) Direct the Government of India to prosecute and take
Action to ensure that illegal online lotteries do not operate
On the Internet in so far as the citizens of India are
concerned.
- (d) Direct the aforesaid respondent to pay compensation as
May be deemed just and proper, for
Running/conducting/operating illegal online lotteries, to
The exchequer that represents the general public based in
India.

After notice to the respondent, Sh.Sunder Lal,Advocate
appeared for the respondent.

Today, learned counsel for the appellant has filed an
